

Admissions Policy

General

- Tickets purchased are only valid for the day purchased on your visit or date booked for advance bookings unless otherwise stated.
- Please check our calendar for opening dates and times.
- Carers of disabled persons are allowed free entry with proof of carer status as outlined on our website.
- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or an adult aged 18 or over and at all times within the park.
- Unless tickets are booked in advance, entrance is not guaranteed.
- Entry may be restricted due to capacity or matters outside of our control such as adverse weather.
- Tickets purchased online will have a booking reference number e-mailed to the email address provided once payment has been confirmed. This reference number is used to redeem the pre-booked tickets upon arrival at the park.
- Tickets remain the property of BeWILDerwood, are non-refundable, not for re-sale, and non-transferable. For pre-booked tickets, the date of the visit can be altered but may be subject to an administration fee.
- We regret that refunds cannot be offered in the event of cancellations, nonattendance or forced closure of the park due to matters outside our control including adverse weather conditions, except in exceptional circumstances at our discretion. We will consider exceptional circumstances such as illness/injury usually within one hour of ticket purchase (or park entry if pre-booked). Any request for a special consideration must be done in writing to the office including proof of purchase (receipt).
- We cannot guarantee all activities will be operational each day visited, but we will try our very best.
- The management reserves the right to refuse entrance to any ticket-holder, and in the interest of the public, and for safety reasons, we also reserve the right to require guests to leave the park at any time.
- Weight and height restrictions apply to a small number of activities in the park for the benefit of your health and safety. These are posted at the activities within the park and are as follows:
 - Minimum height for the Wobbly Wires: 105cm (3'5").
 - Maximum weight for the Wobbly Wires: 101kg (16 stone).
 - Minimum height for the Slippery Slopes & Broken Bridge: 92cm (3').

Children slightly below these height limits may be permitted provided the adult responsible for them is satisfied they are competent enough and will remain safe and under their control. Some disabilities may restrict participation.

- We reserve the right to ask WILD WILD WILD Pass holders to leave the park at any time.
- WILD WILD WILD Passes are valid for 12 months from the date of issue.
- WILD WILD WILD Passes can only be used for admission to BeWILDerwood, throughout the open season as indicated by our opening times on our website.
- Any added benefits offered with the pass are at our discretion. BeWILDerwood reserve the right to vary any benefits without prior notice.
- WILD WILD WILD Passes remain the property of BeWILDerwood, and are not for resale, are non-refundable and non-transferable.
